


15 So he made a whip out of cords, and drove all from the temple courts, both sheep and cattle;

7 For I endure scorn for your sake, and shame covers my face.

9 Zeal for your house consumes me, and the insults of those who insult you fall on me.

1 Cor 3:16-17 (NIV)

Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in your midst?

> If anyone **destroys** God's temple, **God** will destroy that person;

for God's temple is **sacred**, and **you together** are that temple.



Ephesians 2:20-22 (NASB)
